**HIS STORY:** Bryant, Neville, born and raised in Dinwiddie County, shows us how he rolls everyday!

Thirty years ago, a car crash left 17-year old James Bryant Neville a quadriplegic. He was left wondering how he would ever get through a life he never imagined.

Through the help of community members of Dinwiddie and surrounding counties, they planned walk-a-thons, auctions, a softball tournament, and a dance. The community was able to raise money to help modify his families home and purchase a handicap accessible van.

"It was these kind acts that gave me the courage and strength to learn to live again and reach dreams that I initially assumed were dashed. I am who I am because of that support." - Bryant

Three decades later, Bryant Neville is a chief financial officer of a bank, a husband, and a father.

Bryant is recounting his 30 year journey in his upcoming book "On a Roll" and is launching a national partnership with NSCIA which will use Bryant's example and his story to highlight the possibilities for others with spinal cord injuries and disorders.
